

General Information

Idaho City Days is a walking event. We encourage you to park in designated areas and enjoy meandering around our town. Businesses, vendors and event activities are located along Highway 21, up and Down Main St, Montgomery St and up to Centerville Road as well as on the cross streets of Walulla, Commercial and Wall, at the Roy Robison Community Center and in Naylor and Brogan Parks (behind the Boise Basin Museum). See maps placed conveniently around town during the event or here on this site as the weekend gets closer for more specifics.

Idaho City Days Information Booth: Idaho City Chamber provides Information via postings at major cross streets throughout the city and at the Visitor's Center. Find schedules and maps posted at major intersections and gathering points around town during the event and prior to the event.

Pets Welcome: For the safety of animals & visitors, please have pets on a leash at all times.

First Aid: East Boise County Ambulance provides First Aid during Idaho City Days. The First Aid tent is noted on the map. If you have an emergency, please call 911 immediately. Please bring lost children to this location!

Keep it Green: Boise County, City of Idaho City, Idaho City Historical Foundation, and Idaho City Chamber of Commerce have teamed up to help with cleanliness efforts. Please use the trash bins located throughout the city and parks for your convenience.

Handicapped Services: Limited handicapped parking is available in the marked lots near the Roy Robison Community Center and Boise Basin Visitors Center. Restrooms for handicapped persons are located near the Food Court, in the Roy Robison Community Center and in the Boise Basin Visitors Center. (See posted maps for these locations)

Lost & Found: Please turn all items in to the Visitor's Center.

Beer Garden: Have a seat and relax with a cold beer or a chilled bottle of water at the Idaho City Historical Foundations Beer Garden, see the posted maps for location. Service begins at 11:00 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. By special permission of the City Council and the City Police Department feel free to wander the event with your beer, you are not required to be in the beer garden or bars during event hours as long as you follow the stipulations provided by your location of purchase.

Free Parking: (See Maps)

- Downtown
- Main St between Hwy 21 & Walulla St
- Boise Basin Visitors Center Parking Lot
 - Tom's Service Gas Station Side Lot
 - North of town
- ½ Mile past Main St on Hwy21. Rodeo Grounds on left and Ball fields and skate park on right. Please use Crosswalk and Green Belt to walk to town.
- Boise Basin School and Football Field
- At the end of Montgomery St and in High School parking lot on Centerville Road.
- Roy Robison Community Center
 - Airfield
- Left on Commercial St. past the Community Center at the end of Wall St (about ½ mile)
